DELINEATION OF PRIVILEGES AND CRITERIA

PRACTICE AREA: Diagnostic Radiology

In order to be eligible to request clinical privileges for advanced interventional procedures, a practitioner must meet the following minimum threshold criteria:

BASIC EDUCATION: M.D. or D.O.

MINIMAL FORMAL TRAINING:

Successful completion of a postgraduate residency program in General Radiology approved by the ACGME or AOA or its equivalent.

REQUIRED PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE:

The successful applicant must be able to demonstrate that he/she has performed and interpreted at least 100 advanced interventional procedures during the past 12 months of practice.

SUPPLEMENTAL PRIVILEGES IN RADIOLOGY:

I hereby request Advanced Interventional Procedures privileges as follows:

- 9 Guided biopsies using fluoroscopy, CT, or ultrasound of deep solid masses or organs,
- 9 Pulmonary biopsies,
- 9 Puncture and drainage of fluid collection and abscesses.

I understand that in making this request I am bound by the applicable Medical Staff Bylaws and Rules and Regulations, or policies of the hospital, and hereby stipulate that I meet the threshold criteria for each request.
