

Allergy and Immunology

Basic Education: M.D. or D.O.

Minimal formal training: Successful completion of any ACGME or AOA-approved residency training program in internal medicine or pediatrics; at least two (2) years of approved residency or fellowship in allergy and immunology or completion of an approved residency program in internal medicine, pediatrics or family practice with a minimum of six (6) months of training in pediatric or adult allergy and immunology. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified in appropriate field.

Required previous Experience: For individuals, who have completed an approved fellowship program in allergy and immunology, applicants must demonstrate that care was provided to at least twelve (12) patients in the past twelve (12) months.

Core privileges: Ability to admit, work up and provide non-surgical therapy and consultation for patients presenting with allergic or immunologic conditions.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

I understand that it is my obligation to notify the President of the Medical Staff of any procedure or mode of medical care in which I might engage that is not listed. I certify to the best of my knowledge, I am qualified and have professional liability insurance coverage for practice within the scope of privileges requested.
