

General Dentistry

- Basic Education:** DDS or DMD
- Minimal formal training:** Successful completion of an approved one-year general hospital practice training program or formal two year graduate general dentistry dental residency.
- Required previous Experience:** The applicant must be able to demonstrate that he or she has performed at least 10 hospital based dental procedures in the past eighteen months.
- Core privileges:** Ability to admit, consult, work-up, and provide diagnostic, preventative, and therapeutic oral health care to patients of all ages to correct or treat various routine conditions of the oral cavity.

These core privileges do not include the following:

- Extraction below the gumline
- Preparation of existing jaw bone for oral prosthesis.

Pedodontics includes restorations indicated for proper treatment of primary and/or permanent teeth, placement of appliance for space maintenance, and/or interceptive and preventative orthodontic procedures, minor oral surgery, and mixed dentition pulp therapy.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

I understand that it is my obligation to notify the President of the Medical Staff of any procedure or mode of medical care in which I might engage that is not listed. I certify to the best of my knowledge, I am qualified and have professional liability insurance coverage for practice within the scope of privileges requested.
