

Neurological Surgery

Basic Education: M.D. or D.O.

Minimal Formal Training: Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA-approved residency program in general surgery followed by an approved residency/fellowship-training program in neurological surgery. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified.

Required Experience: Demonstration of the performance of at least 50 neurological surgical procedures over the past 12 months.

Core Privileges: Ability to admit, work up, diagnose and surgically treat patients with illnesses, injuries or disorders of the neurologic system including the provision of consultation as well as ordering diagnostic studies and procedures. Threshold criteria must be established for the following special requests: lumbar fusion, thromboendarterectomy of carotid or vertebral circulation, trigeminal neuralgia, sympathectomy, stereotatic surgery, surgery for vascular malformation of the spinal cord or spinal canal, percutaneous stimulation or destruction of the spinal cord, lower back surgery involving the use of various stabilization devices.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.
