

## Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery

- Basic Education:** DMD or DDS
- Minimal formal training:** The applicant must demonstrate successful completion of an approved residency training program in oral and maxillofacial surgery that includes training for above the palate procedures and histories and physicals. Those physicians without such training must demonstrate current competency by proof of training that included both didactic and hands-on instruction. Must be Board Eligible or Certified.
- Required previous Experience:** The applicant must be able to demonstrate that he or she has performed major oral and maxillofacial surgery on 50 patients no more than five of whom required dentoalveolar surgery. For a major case to be counted toward meeting this requirement, the applicant must have been the operating surgeon or have been supervised by a credential oral and maxillofacial surgeon.
- Core privileges:** Ability to admit, work-up, and the perform surgical procedures on all patients presenting with illnesses, injuries, and disorders of both functional and esthetic aspects of the hard and soft tissues of the oral and maxillofacial regions.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.
