

Pediatrics

Basic Education: M.D. or D.O.

Minimal Formal Training: Successful completion of a three-year pediatric residency program approved by the ACGME or the AOA. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified.

Required Previous Experience: Demonstrate that applicant has provided inpatient care to at least 24 patients as the attending physician or senior resident during the past 24 months.

Core Privileges: Ability to admit, workup, diagnose, and treat patients between birth to 18 years old. Performance of procedures that are not life threatening, related to admission, consultation and work up including: venipuncture, laceration repair, incision and drainage of superficial abscesses and treatment of major complicated illnesses. Must maintain PALS certification. Privileges include ICU admitting privileges.

Newborn Core Privileges: Applicant must meet above criteria and demonstrate evidence of newborn care to at least 24 patients during the past 24 months. Privileges include ability to provide care to all newborns, including those with life-threatening illnesses.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

I understand that it is my obligation to notify the President of the Medical Staff of any procedure or mode of medical care in which I might engage that is not listed. I certify to the best of my knowledge, I am qualified and have professional liability insurance coverage for practice within the scope of privileges requested.
