

Plastic Surgery

Basic Education: M.D. or D.O.

Minimal Formal Education: Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA-approved residency training in an accredited two or three year plastic surgery program. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified.

Required Previous Experience: Demonstration of performance of at least 100 plastic surgery procedures during the past 12 months or successful participation in a hospital-affiliated formalized residency or special clinical fellowship during which at least 250 cases were performed or assisted by applicant.

Core Privileges: Ability to admit, work up and perform surgical procedures for patients of all ages for treatment of skin neoplasm's, diseases, and trauma that can include benign and malignant lesions of the skin and soft tissue, reconstructive grafts and flaps, scar revisions, and laser therapy for vascular lesions. Surgery of the breast that includes breast reconstruction, breast reduction, breast biopsy, congenital anomalies and mastectomy (subcutaneous and simple). Treatment of facial diseases and injuries including; maxillofacial structures, facial fractures including the mandible, nose deformity, ear deformity, jaw deformity, eyelid deformity, cleft lip and palate deformity, craniofacial surgery, skull base surgery, facial deformity and wound treatment, tumors of the head and neck. Surgery of the hand and extremities including hand wounds, tendon injuries, fractures of the hand and wrist, carpal tunnel syndrome (endoscopic and open), Dupuytren's contracture, surgery for rheumatoid arthritis, congenital anomalies, tumors of the bones and soft tissue. Reconstructive microsurgery including microvascular flaps, grafts/free tissue transfer, replantation and revascularization of the upper and lower extremities and digits, reconstruction of peripheral nerves. Reconstruction of congenital and acquired defects of the trunk and genitalia including vaginal reconstruction, repair of penis deformities, gender reassignment, chest and abdominal wall reconstruction. Complex wound healing and burn treatment including initial burn management and acute and reconstructive burn treatment. Cosmetic surgery including body contouring, facial contouring, breast augmentation, breast lift, cosmetic rhytidectomy, cosmetic blepharoplasty, subcutaneous injections, skin peeling and dermabrasion, vein injection sclerotherapy, liposuction, endoscopic cosmetic surgery and laser therapy for vascular and cutaneous lesions.

I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

Conscious Sedation <input type="checkbox"/>	Successful completion of an accredited residency of at least three year's duration. <i>Note: If the applicant's training program did not include four weeks of anesthesia training (including IV sedation, indications, contraindications, pre-anesthesia assessment, intra-operative care, procedure monitoring, and post-anesthesia care), the applicant must demonstrate successful completion of an accredited training sequence involving both didactic and practical components.</i>	Performance of IV sedation for at least 50 patients during the past 18 months.	
Liposuction <input type="checkbox"/>	Successful completion of an accredited residency in plastic surgery.	Performance of at least 50 surgical procedures designed to shape and contour the body; and Evidence of at least 30 continuing medical education hours covering indications for, technical aspects of, and post-procedure manage of liposuction (if not covered by the applicant's residency).
