

Behavioral Medicine

Basic Education: M.D. or D.O.

Minimal Formal Training: Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA-approved residency program in psychiatry. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified.

Required Previous Experience: Demonstration that applicant has provided inpatient, outpatient, or consultative services for at least 30 patients during the past 12 months.

Core Privileges: Ability to admit, work up, diagnose, and treat for patients above the age of 14 who suffer from mental, behavioral or emotional disorders. Privileges include providing consultation with physicians in other fields regarding mental, behavioral or emotional disorders.
Core privileges do not include privileges in addiction medicine, hypnosis, amytal interview, group and family therapy, use and interpretation of psychological tests, behavioral modification, consultation to the courts, emergency psychiatry, ECT.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

I understand that it is my obligation to notify the President of the Medical Staff of any procedure or mode of medical care in which I might engage that is not listed. I certify to the best of my knowledge, I am qualified and have professional liability insurance coverage for practice within the scope of privileges requested.

Privileges requested	Minimum formal training	Required previous experience	Reappointment criteria
Biofeedback <input type="checkbox"/>	Licensure in an individual practice area; and Certification by the Biofeedback Certification Institute of America (BCIA), which requires 200 hours of formal training in the following three areas: Didactic education in biofeedback; Personal experience in biofeedback; and Supervised clinical experience in biofeedback.	Successful completion of 140 hours of clinical biofeedback training under supervision of a professional who meets BCIA requirements.	Successful completion of the BCIA's continuing formal education requirements Or Successful completion of the BCIA's written examination. Recertification is every four years.
Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) <input type="checkbox"/>	Successful completion of an accredited residency in psychiatry.	Provision of at least 20 ECT treatments on at least three different patients during the past 12 months, each of which, included: Evaluation of the patient for treatment need and suitability; Immediate post-treatment follow-up; and Evaluation of the completion of the treatment course.
