- Basic Education:** Ph.D., PsyD and Associate Psychologist
- Minimal Formal Training:** The successful applicant must demonstrate successful completion of an approved doctoral degree or master's program from a regionally accredited program.
- Required Formal Education:** Demonstration that the applicant has provided inpatient, outpatient, or consultative services for at least 15 patients during the past 12 months.
- Core Privileges** Work up, diagnosis, treatment, counseling, and psychological testing to patients above the age of 14 who suffer from mental, behavioral or emotional disorders. Privileges include providing consultation with physicians in other fields regarding mental, behavioral or emotional disorders. Core privileges do not include privileges in addiction medicine, amytal interview, and ECT.
- Reappointment:** Reappointment should be based on unbiased, objective results of care according to the hospital's clinical outcomes mechanisms. The applicant must demonstrate that he or she has maintained competence by demonstrating that he or she has met the hospital's minimum requirements for Psychology privileges.
- Other** Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competence may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested.
