Basic Education: MD or DO

Minimal formal training: Successful completion of any ACGME or AOA-approved residency training program in internal medicine and completion of a fellowship in rheumatology. Must be Board Eligible or Board Certified in both Internal Medicine and Rheumatology.

Required previous Experience: The successful applicant must be able to demonstrate that he or she has provided inpatient or consultative services for at least 24 patients during the past 12 months.

Core Privileges Ability to admit, work up, diagnose, and provide treatment or consultative services to patients of all ages presenting with rheumatic diseases. Privileges include diagnostic aspiration of synovial fluid from diarthrodial joints, bursae, and tenosynovial structures and therapeutic injection of diarthrodial joints, bursae, tenosynovial structures, and entheses.

Other privileges requested for which you have current clinical competency may be listed below. Documentation of training and/or experience must be provided for any special privileges requested. I understand that by making this request, I am bound by the applicable laws and policies of the Medical Center and hereby stipulate that I meet the minimum threshold criteria for this request.

I understand that it is my obligation to notify the President of the Medical Staff of any procedure or mode of medical care in which I might engage that is not listed. I certify to the best of my knowledge, I am qualified and have professional liability insurance coverage for practice within the scope of privileges requested.
