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Delineation of Core Privileges
Category I

A) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Education:

- Nurse Practitioner Masters' Degree

Minimum Formal Training: Successful completion of a nurse practitioner nursing program.

Experience: Applicant must have at least 12 months of clinical experience and expertise in the nurse practitioner area of specialization in the past five years.

Board Certification:

- Certified by the American Nurses Credentialing Center

Clinical References:

- As outlined in the Procedure for Appointment, Reappointment and Clinical Privileges of Allied Health Professionals of the Heart Hospital of New Mexico.

B) RECREDENTIALING CRITERIA: Applicants must demonstrate their maintained competence with evidence that they have provided NP inpatient or outpatient services for at least 50 patients in the previous two (2) years. Failure to meet the recredentialing criteria will require appeal to the Medical Executive Committee.

C) PRIVILEGES: Initial and ongoing assessment of patients' medical, physical, and psychosocial status, including the following:

- Perform history and physical examination
- Dictate history and physical examination results
- Perform or assist in the performance of routine office, laboratory or patient screening procedures
- Conduct rounds, develop and implement patient management plans, record progress notes, and provide continuity of care
- Perform/interpret laboratory, radiologic, cardiographic and other diagnostic procedures used to identify pathophysiologic processes
- Assist the supervising physician in institutional settings, including reviewing treatment plans and ordering tests and diagnostic laboratory/radiological services
- Order therapies, using procedures reviewed and approved by the supervising physician
- Write orders for medications, treatment tests, and IV fluids consistent with the scope of practice of the NP and the supervising physician
- Provide first-assist services in surgery (*Documentation of training & competency required*)
- Provide pre- and postoperative surgical care
- Cleanse and debride wounds and suture lacerations and remove sutures and staples
- Perform venipuncture
- Perform electrocardiogram tracing
- Apply and remove orthopedic casts and traction
- Insert indwelling urinary catheters
- Write/dictate discharge summaries
- Provide patient education and counseling
