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Delineation of Core Privileges

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: To be able to request these clinical privileges, the applicant must meet the criteria below:

1. **MD, DO**
2. **Completed additional education/training as follows:**
 - Completion of an Ophthalmology Training program, and
 - Certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology.

NEW APPLICANTS MUST complete Board Certification within 5 years of application/approved Medical Staff membership.

3. **Be able to secure clinical references as outlined in the Policy On Appointment, Reappointment and Clinical Privileges of the Medical Staff of the Heart Hospital of New Mexico.**

OPHTHALMOLOGY CORE I PRIVILEGES

Performance of Ophthalmology procedures (including related admission, consultation, work-up, pre-and post-operative care) to correct or treat various ophthalmologic conditions, illnesses and injuries.

A representative, but of necessity not complete list of OPTHALMOLOGY CORE I procedures is stated below. It is assumed that other procedures and problems of similar complexity will fall within the identified NON-CORE OPTHALMOLOGY privileges.

THE MINIMUM CRITERIA OF 25 OPTHALMOLOGY CORE I PROCEDURES ARE REQUIRED WITHIN TWO (2) YEARS (This criteria can also be met by documentation from other hospital affiliations.)

- Removal of superficial foreign bodies
- Repair of eyelid lacerations
- Surgery Techniques needed for trauma/emergency care
- Enucleation
- Retrolubar injection
- Dilation of lacrimal puncta
