Delineation Of Core Privileges

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: To be able to request these clinical privileges, the applicant must meet the criteria below:

1. **MD, DO**
2. **Completed additional education/training as follows:**
 - Completion of an accredited Residency in Radiation Oncology
 - Be Certified by the American Board of Radiology.

NEW APPLICANTS MUST BE Board Certified within 5 years of application/approved Medical Staff membership.

3. **Have the following past experience:**
 - Have been in the active practice of Radiation Oncology in a Department which has quality assurance programs during the past two years.
4. Be able to secure clinical references as outlined in the Policy On Appointment, Reappointment and Clinical Privileges of the Medical Staff of the Heart Hospital of New Mexico.

RADIOLOGY ONCOLOGY CORE I PRIVILEGES

Non-Core Privileges

Brachytherapy

1. Eligibility Criteria:

In addition to the eligibility criteria for Core I Radiation Oncology privileges:

- A. Documented attendance at an approved didactic Brachytherapy course to include a mock case **AND**
- B. At least three cases must be proctored prior to proceeding independently.

2. Maintenance Requirements:

- A. Applicant **must** perform 10 brachytherapy procedures with a satisfactory quality record over a two-year period to maintain non-provisional privileges.
