Blood Reagents Settlement



We are excited to announce that our partners at Class Action Capital have notified us of a recent class action settlement opportunity that is highly relevant to our members.

This is a \$41.5 million settlement that resolves allegations over whether Immocur and Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics violated federal law by manipulating the price of traditional blood reagents. Traditional blood reagents are designed to identify certain properties of the cell and serum components of human blood. Your facility is likely eligible for a refund if they purchased blood reagents directly from the defendants between November 4, 2000 through October 19, 2015. The filing deadline for this settlement is February 20, 2019.
